The internship will be for a period of six weeks with a stipend of \$150 each week. It is expected that 20 hours/week will be devoted to the internship. However, the exact number of hours, distribution during the week, as well as distribution during the six week period will be determined by the editor of the newspaper with whom you will intern.

The internship is open to undergraduate students who will have completed at least their sophomore year in college by the end of **May 2017**. Enrolled graduate students are also eligible.

Undergraduate students must submit an official transcript of their undergraduate program.

Graduate students must submit an official undergraduate transcript and transcripts for their present graduate studies.

It may be helpful to acquaint yourself with the "**The Armenian Weekly**" and "**The Armenian Mirror-Spectator.**" Both newspapers are located in Watertown, MA.
