The internship will be for a period of **six (6) weeks** with a stipend of \$150 each week. It is expected that 20 hours/week will be devoted to the internship. However, the exact number of hours, distribution during the week, as well as distribution during the six week period will be determined by the editor of the newspaper with whom you will intern.

The internship is open to students who will have completed their sophomore year in college by the end of May 2012. Enrolled graduate students are also eligible.

Applicants will first be reviewed by the ASA Inc. Those selected will participate in a second round of interviews with the editors before finalists are announced.

It may be helpful to acquaint yourself with the "**The Armenian Weekly**" (Khatchig Mouradian, editor) and "**The Armenian Mirror-Spectator**" (Alin K. Gregorian, editor). Both newspapers are located in Watertown, Massachusetts.
